- >> Khan Sahib was conferred mainly on Muslim, Parsi, Irani and Jewish.

Rai/Rao/Khan which means brave/price in respective areas was the first degree of honor followed by the word sahib which means Sir, for example - Khan Sahib followed by bahadur which means brave, for example - Rai Bahadur.

Historical Importance:

Mir Jafar was a military general under Siraj ud-Daulah, the Nawab of Bengal, Mir Jafar had a dream of becoming a Nawab & he saw an opportunity to join hands with the Britishers during the battle of Plassey where Mir Jafar did not obey the order of nawab and an army of 50,000 soldiers was defeated by the British army of 3500 soldiers.

Mir Jafar later killed Siraj and was appointed as Nawab in his place. But he became little more than a puppet ruler, forced to cede control of Bengal through the treaties he signed with the British. Siraj's defeat also meant that the French were no longer a force in Bengal. The Bengal treasury allowed the Company to strengthen its military might and start the expansion of British control of the Indian subcontinent.

The Persia clasp was the first one in the IGS-54 series that was awarded for overseas service to the British-Indian Army. The Persian war (Dec 1856-Apr 1857) was triggered by the annexation of Herat by the Persians and the British retaliated with a land and sea expedition. The first Victoria Cross to the British-Indian Army was awarded in this campaign. The 'Mooltan' clasp was awarded for the siege of Mooltan during the 2nd Anglo-Sikh war in 1848.49. Abramjee Israel belonged to the Bene Israel community whose members were recruited into the army of the Bombay Presidency. The 4th Regiment of Native Infantry was involved in the assault on the fortress of Mooltan.
